<p><u>Individual School Reopening Plans and FAQs</u></p> <p>During this week, your student's school will be sending specific details of what each school will look like during the 2020-21 school year.</p> <p>This information will include district and school specific safety protocols, a sample of a typical day, and FAQs.</p>	<p><u>First day of the 2020-21 School Year</u></p> <p>The School Board has moved the start of the school year to Wednesday, September 9th.</p> <p>This will allow staff time for professional development and planning prior to students beginning on September 9th.</p> <p>Students choosing full remote will begin school on this day as well.</p>	<p><u>Phased-in Reopening Model</u></p> <p>There will be a “phased in” approach to full reopening. During this time, students will follow Blended Model C (every other day cohorts alternating in-person instruction with remote instruction).</p> <p>This will allow students and teachers to experience the remote setting for a short period of time.</p> <p>Students choosing full remote will engage in remote learning only.</p>	<p><u>Deadline for Student Participation in Q1 or Trimester 1 Learning Model</u></p> <p>Parents and students (K-2) will be required to choose the 5 day in-school instruction model or a full remote option. Parents and students (3-12) will be required to choose the hybrid model or a full remote option to begin on Sept. 28th.</p> <p>Students will be locked into the model they chose until the end of the quarter or trimester.</p>	<p><u>Start of Phase 2 of Reopening.</u></p> <p>Students will start the adjusted model on Sept. 28 based on the finalized selection you chose on the Sept. 21 deadline.</p> <p>Students will be locked into the model they chose until the end of the quarter or trimester.</p>
